#### **Our accommodation**


We will stay at Hotel Cheyenne in the Disneyland resort for 2 nights.

We recommend that students take around €40 with them for food at Disneyland Paris, and then it is up to you for spends.




#### **Travel tips – packing**







#### **Sunday**


- Arrive at ferry terminal and check in at Dover for 3.20am.


