2 Membership

- 2.1 The committee shall consist of not less than four Governors.
- 2.2 The committee shall have such co-opted non-voting members as is thought appropriate.

3 Election of Chair and Vice Chair

The committee shall elect a chair and vice chair at its first meeting of the academic year.

4 Quorum

The quorum shall be three Governors

5 Meetings

The committee shall meet a minimum of once per term.

6 Minutes

The minutes shall be taken by the Clerk to the Governing Body or an appropriate alternative.

7 Review of Terms of Reference

The Terms of Reference shall be reviewed annually by the committee and ratified by the full Governing Body.

8 Terms of Reference

- 8.1 Seek assurance from the school leadership that the full Governing Body (FGB) has all necessary curriculum related policies to meet statutory and local requirements.
- 8.2 Where delegation has been agreed by the FGB, establish and review the effectiveness of statutory policies, plans and procedures relating to achievement and teaching related matters:
 - Assessment, Recording and Reporting Policy
 - Curriculum Policy
 - Homework Policy
 - Relationships and Sex Education Policy
 - SEN Policy
- 8.3 Where delegation has been agreed by the FGB, establish and review the effectiveness of nonstatutory policies, plans and procedures relating to achievement and teaching-related matters including:
 - Agreeing and reviewing policies on PSHCE, Collective Worship, Religious Education, Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural development
 - Agreeing and reviewing policies and practices on Inclusion and ASD provision
 - Oversight of a policy for educational visits, including the appointment of a named co-ordinator
- 8.4 Consider and advise the FGB on matters relating to the school's curriculum, including any statutory requirements delegated to the committee, including:
 - E-safety
 - Drug education
- 8.5 Consider curricular issues which have implications for financial and human resource decisions and make recommendations to the relevant committee or the Governing Body.
- 8.6 Arrange for online information to be published on the Pupil Premium allocation, its use and impact on attainment.
- 8.7 Arrange for online information to be published on the curriculum provision, content and approach, by year and by subject.
