

Apps



Once logged into Office 365, our students are able to use all of the Microsoft Office packages free of charge (Teams, Powerpoint, Word, Excel etc) and can store their work in OneDrive.



Homework

Homework at De La Salle is set using the Assignments function in Microsoft Teams. Students are able to set the app to receive



notifications when a new homework has been set and should be checking this section on a daily basis.

All parents / guardians will receive a weekly email from Teams showing the assignments that have been set for your child for the week that has just passed and for the following week. For each assignment, you will either see that it has been completed, or you will see the due date if it has not been completed. This will be sent to the email address that we hold for you on our records in school.

Homework can take many forms but should include a combination of links to relevant websites, video clips, quizzes, reflective tasks, revision, creative tasks etc.

Directions for returning homework should be clear in the 'Assignment', for example complete the online quiz and submit or create a piece of art and upload a photo. Students are encouraged to speak to their class teacher or send their teacher a direct message using the chat function in Teams if they are not sure about any aspect of their homework.

We are in the process of reintegrating Satchel: One (formerly Show My Homework) to our homework systems which will allow parents / guardians to view more information about student's homework and deadlines. Once we have completed the set up for this, we will send out more information about logging on.

Edulink One is a way for students and parents/guardians to view timetables, catering account, achievement points, behaviour points and more.


