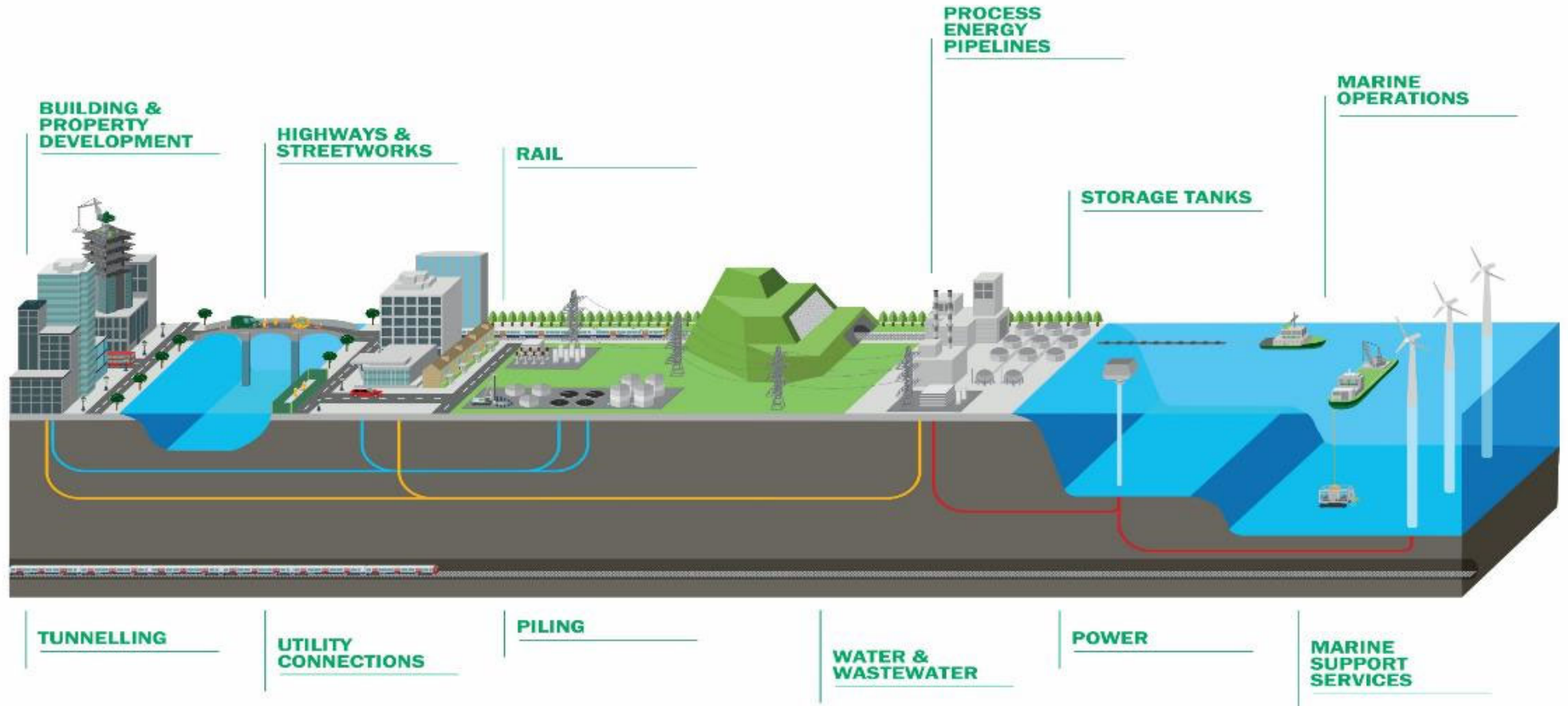

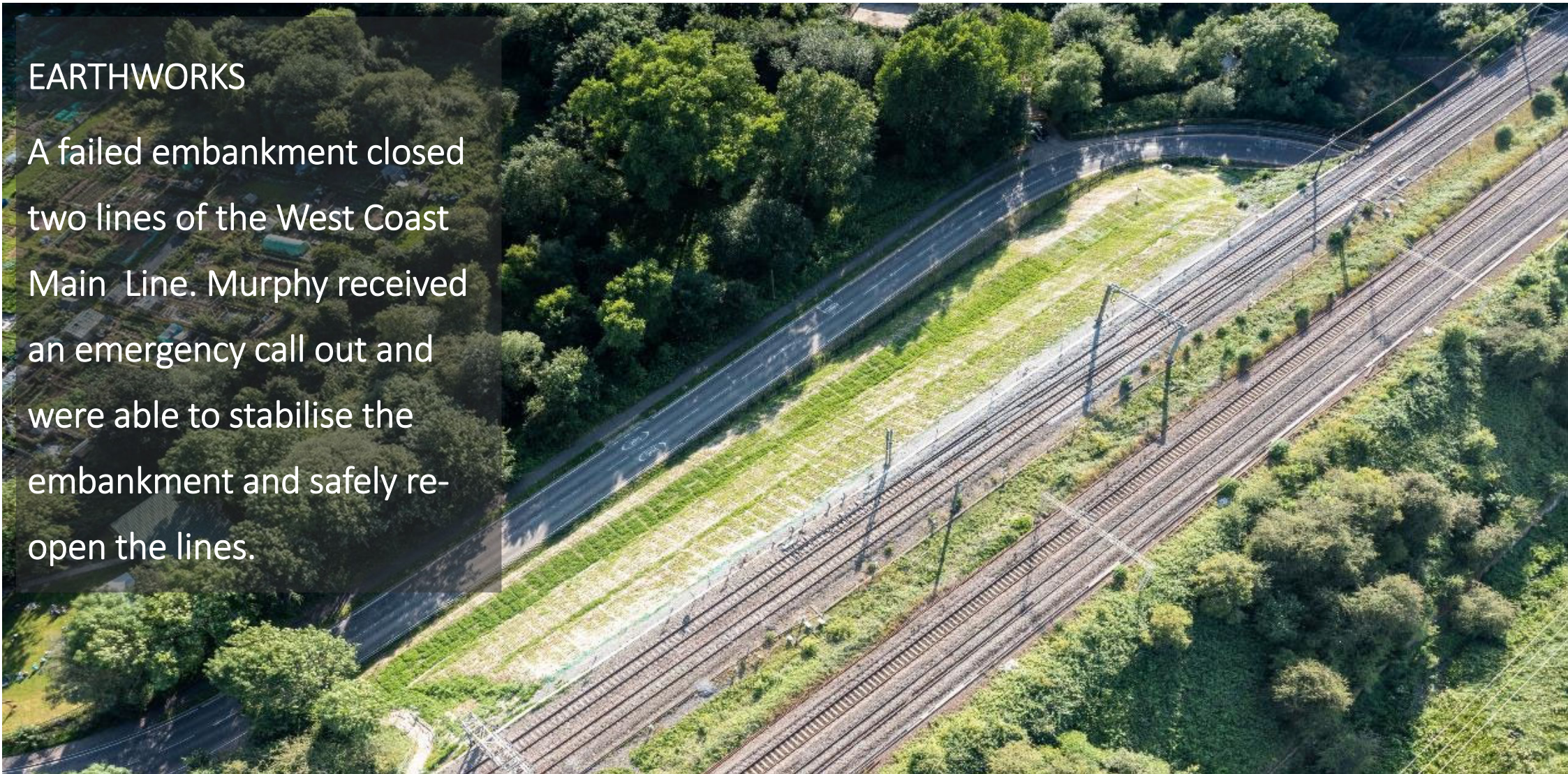


STRUCTURES

EARTHWORKS

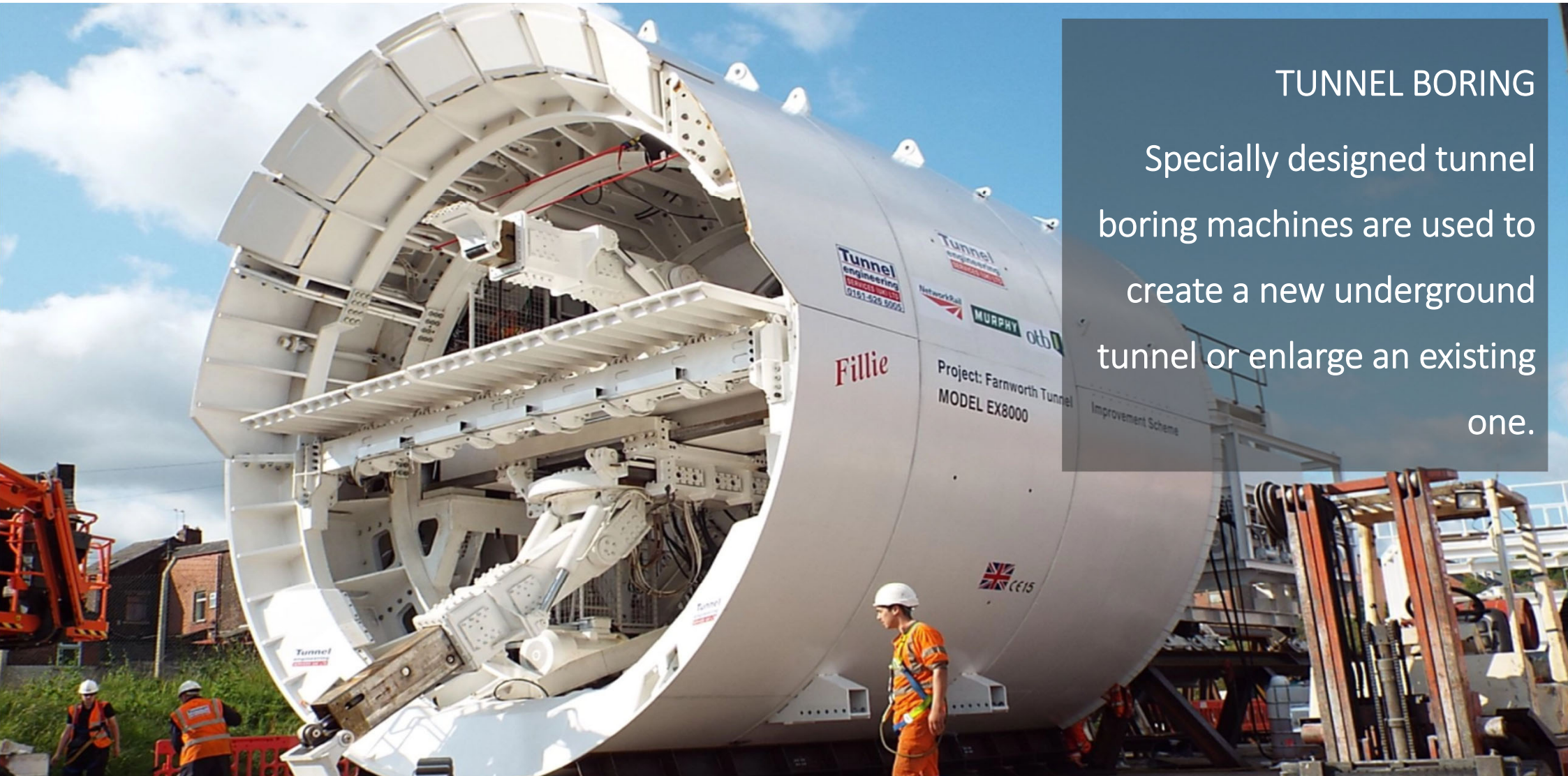
A failed embankment closed two lines of the West Coast Main Line. Murphy received an emergency call out and were able to stabilise the embankment and safely re-open the lines.

What is the Civil Service, MoJ & LAA?

- The **Civil Service** helps the government of the day develop and implement its policies as effectively as possible.
- **MoJ** – Ministry of Justice – Courts, Prisons,
- **Legal Aid Agency** – Provides funding for the public in matters where legal expertise is required.

Civil Service Apprenticeships

- The Civil Service Fast Track Apprenticeship is a two-year Level 4 higher apprenticeship. Applicants can choose from 6 schemes, each a genuine alternative to university. It is a permanent position within a government department.
- As part of the Civil Service, apprentices are working in our many professions to make Britain healthier, safer and more prosperous.

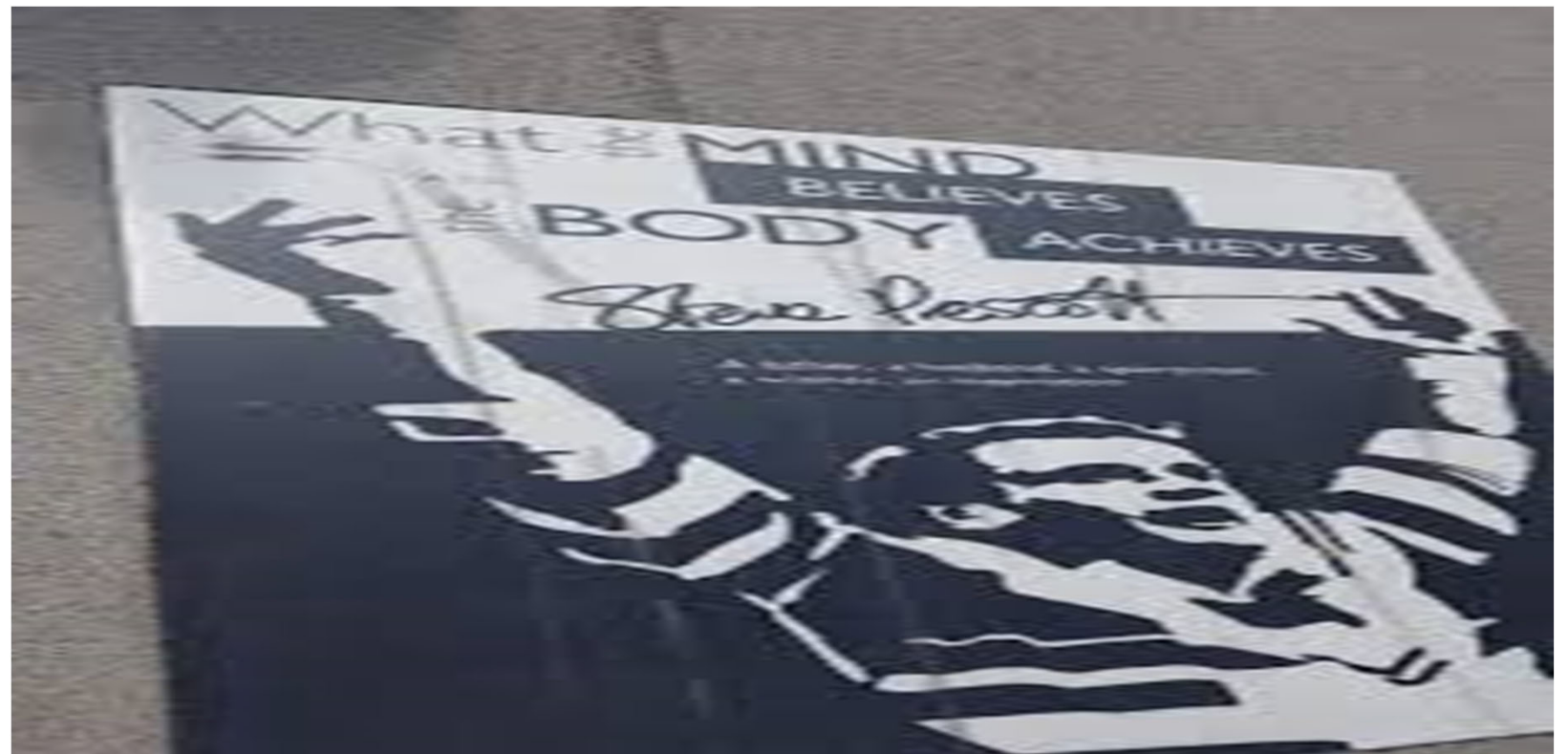

Sorry we can't be with you today, we have put together a few slides to inform you about the *Civil Service*.

Many of you may not have heard of or know much about the *Civil Service* so we will give you some information over the next few slides.



The Civil Service delivers public services and supports the government of the day to develop and implement its policies.

The work civil servants do touches all aspects of life in the UK, from education and the environment, to transport and defence.

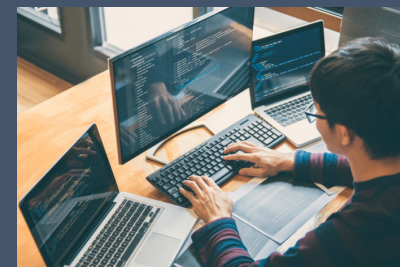
Civil servants are politically impartial. Together, we ensure the effective running of government and provide the best possible services to the public.



Whatever you do, and wherever you work, a job in the Civil Service is an opportunity to make a difference.



You could be working as a vet, a customer service adviser, a weapons engineer, a marine biologist or a web developer, to name a few.





We employ 420,000 people across the country and overseas, and there are over 400 different departments and agencies.



Our work is everything from advising ministers on policy, to delivering front line services to the public.

So as you can see if you can think of a job title there is probably a Civil Servant doing that role somewhere in the country.



We have a saying in the Civil Service

First you start with **A** - a job, then you get **B** - better job and finally
you get **C** - your career

This is worth remembering when you start out, you may change the company you work for or you could stay with the same firm but move about and up the ladder within the company. There is no right or wrong route you just need to find your own way.

HOW TO JOIN THE CIVIL SERVICE

There is more than one way to join the Civil Service, we have Civil Service Apprenticeships, Early Diversity Internships, Summer Diversity Internships, the Civil Service Fast Stream and Direct Entry.

Civil Service Apprenticeships

Join the Civil Service as an Apprentice and help to Build The Future. Opportunities available include Higher & Degree level apprenticeships in addition to apprenticeships equivalent to GCSE and A level.

Since 2015, the Civil Service has recruited over 29,000 apprentices across multiple locations, departments and professions.

An apprenticeship puts you in a paid position whilst you study for a professional accreditation.

Early Diversity Internship



Early Diversity Internship

We offer a short internship for first-year undergraduates from diverse backgrounds. This is an ideal way to learn more about a career in the Civil Service.

Of those who completed the internship in 2019 and were surveyed, 100% recommended it.

It is for 1 week in London and all expenses are paid, and is a great foundation for applying to the Summer Diversity Internship Programme.

Summer Diversity Internship



Summer Diversity Internship

Our multi-award winning programme that gives talented people from diverse backgrounds, in their final 2 years of undergraduate study, the opportunity to see what a career in the Civil Service is like.

Attending this internship gives you the chance to be fast tracked if you apply for the Fast Stream.

It lasts for 6-9 weeks, is paid £300-£350 per week and is UK wide.

Civil Service Fast Stream



Civil Service Fast Stream

This is an accelerated path into leadership in the Civil Service for graduates and civil servants. In 2020, we were, for the second year running, Number 1 in 'The Times Top 100 Graduate Employers' listing.

There is a choice of 15 schemes, each within a profession, and the opportunity to contribute to fast-paced work that makes a difference to the whole of society.

The starting salary is £27,000 and earning potential on completion is £45-55,000.

Direct Entry - Civil Service Jobs



Civil Service Jobs

You don't have to join an Apprenticeship or Graduate Programme to become a civil servant. You can use the 'Direct Entry' route by applying for live vacancies. We are always recruiting and have a large number of wide-ranging vacancies available at any given time. The Civil Service Jobs portal allows you to sign up for job alerts tailored to your skills and experience when you create an account on the site.

When looking on Civil Service Jobs I would suggest to look at the job description rather than relying on the job title as it may not be what it at first seems to be.

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Sixth Form / Sixth Form College:

At Sixth Form you study A-Levels and/or BTEC National Award/Certificate/Diploma, these are Level 3 qualifications. If you want to go to university you need Level 3 qualifications. A-Levels are usually based on academic subjects and most people study 3/4 subjects. BTEC's are vocational qualifications and can be studied alone or combined with A Levels. To study level 3 qualifications you need to achieve a minimum of grades 4 - 9 depending on your subject choices and place of study.
