# Parental Update 21

It is barely believable that, as restrictions from a 2-year global pandemic come to an end, we find ourselves facing a war in Europe. For us, as adults, with 20, 30 or 40+ years of life experience, that is naturally a cause of concern and anxiety. For our young people, it is hard to understand how they feel about the situation or the scale and depth of the anxiety it will be causing them.

These may or may not be issues that are coming up at home, but I thought you might find it helpful to know the advice we have given staff as it is likely that some of our young people will raise the issue of the attack in Ukraine, war in Europe or even risk of World War 3.

As adults, our role is to be calm, supportive and caring in these conversations. If you find yourself in this position our advice is:

- Remain calm.
- Listen to what they have to say and their concerns.
- Encourage them to get their information from reliable sources e.g. Newsround/BBC/ITV news rather than social media.
- Emphasise how far away Ukraine is (most of the fighting is almost 2,000 miles away (similar distance to North Africa).
- Guide the conversation towards what the students can do about it e.g. support of
  charities and organisations who are there to help (they could go and research
  these) as well as keeping them in our prayers.
- If a child is extremely upset refer them to a member of the pastoral teams, Sam (Chaplain) or the SLT.
