The following guide will give you the criteria and some ideas to get you started and your teacher will arrange for your work to be entered.

When you think of One La Salle, what words come to mind?

Unity, together, equality...

What symbols come to mind?

Circle, hands, the world.

Lasallians are united globally through the symbol of the star, the star of faith.

Your challenge is to design a Christmas card with the following criteria:

- Features a star or stars
- Represents One La Salle in some way either through words or images
- Is appropriate for Christmas.

What do I need to do?

- Design a Christmas card which responds to the theme and the criteria provided.
- You can use any material such as pencil, paint, print, photography. You should be as creative as possible!
- Take a good quality photograph of the design so that one can see only the image. Ensure it is clear and in focus.
