
Documents

Pupils should bring their passports and EHIC cards with them and keep them safe while travelling. They will be collected after they have cleared customs in Barcelona. They will be locked in a safe at the hotel. They will be returned to them on the coach on the way to the airport.

Responsibility

Pupils will be responsible for looking after their own money (a money belt would be a good idea) and devices (phones etc.). Charges for data and phone use overseas can be prohibitive. Parents are advised to make enquiries with their own providers and advise their children appropriately.

A backpack is good idea and it is advisable to wear them on the front as opposed to back in crowds. We will be using the coaches and trains to move around the region so pupils should follow the instructions clearly. Pupils need to be vigilant and certainly should not have phones in back pockets for example.

Clothes

- Footwear should be sensible there will be a lot of walking! Worn in trainers would be good for the main daily activities.
- Clothes should be appropriate for visiting places of worship. We will have the opportunity to visit some beautiful churches.
- Shorts and loose t-shirts will be a comfortable option
- Sun cream most definitely is required as July is a very hot month generally.
- Pupils need to bring a bottle so they can fill it with water to remain hydrated.
- A cap or hat will help to protect you from the sun
- A small shoulder bag/backpack to carry water, sun cream and other items would be useful
- A money belt with a zip which can be concealed will help keep items safe.
- Pupils should bring sleepwear, toiletries and towel.

<u>Luggage</u>

ONLY on board/hand luggage:

This allows students to carry a small personal bag (40x20x25cm), which must fit under the seat, and a 10kg bag (55x40x20cm) onboard, to be stored in the overhead locker. Remember not to pack any liquids containing more than 100ml each. Please put all your toiletries and medicines in a transparent bag.
