- users can quickly learn how to use the HCI

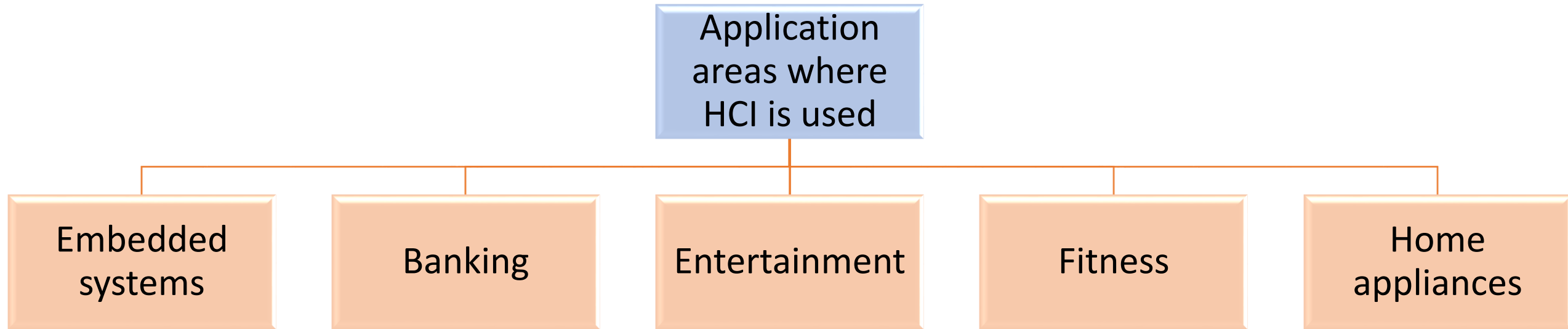
Be user-controlled:

- which means the user decides the actions to be taken

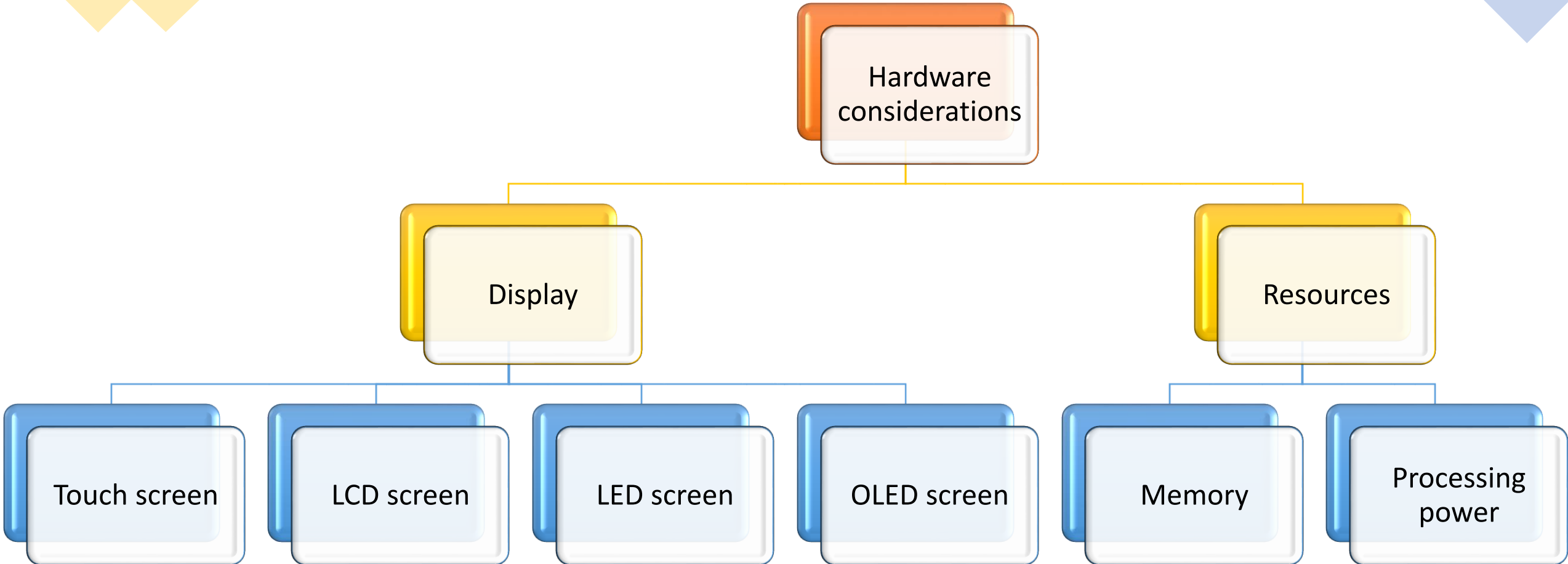
Provides feedback:

- when a user makes an error, the messages should be clear and provide detailed feedback as to how to rectify the error

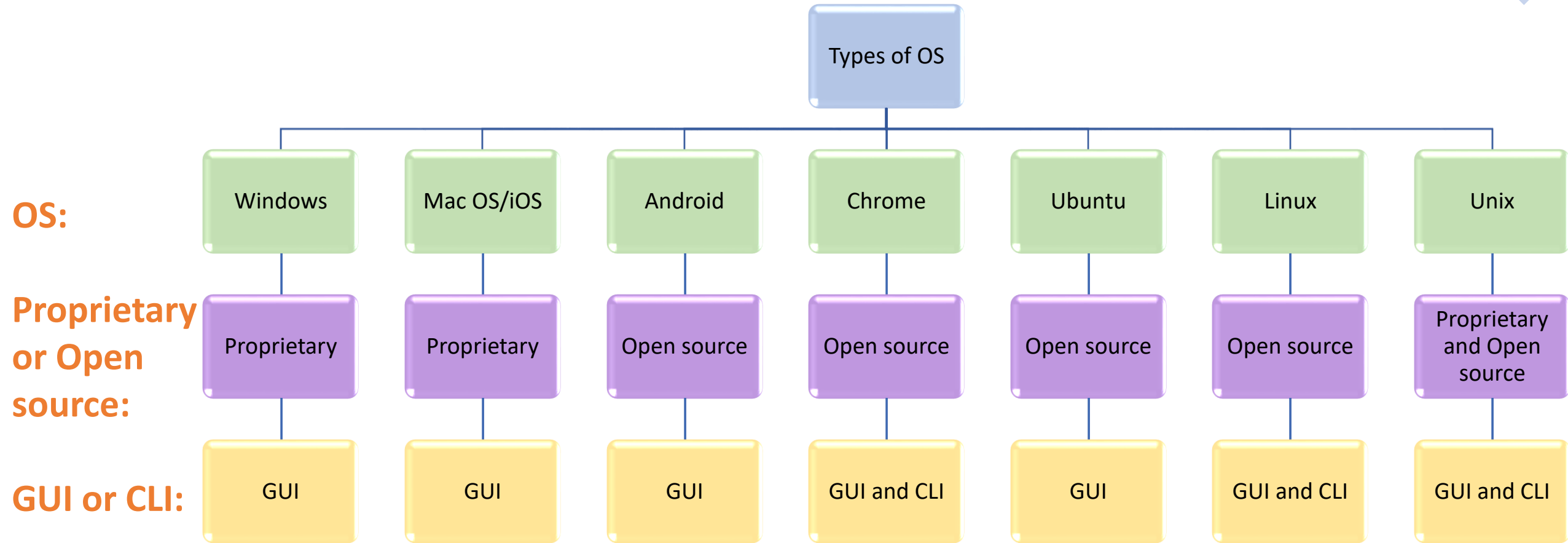
